

TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

Busing Information

Questions should be directed to your local Board of Education, Transportation Department. Parents are notified by late-August concerning the availability, time, and place of transportation.

1. Specifications for non-public school students in New Jersey (State Law): Students enrolled in non-public schools in New Jersey shall receive transportation to and from the non-public school district in which they reside subject to the following conditions:

- A. The district in which the student resides must be one which provides bus transportation for regular school students. Regular public school students do not include those students receiving transportation to vocational schools or special education classes.
- B. Secondary school students must reside more than 2.5 miles from the school that they attend and not more than 20 miles from the school.
- C. The annual aid in lieu of transportation for students shall not exceed \$1,000.00. (The State of New Jersey determines the exact amount.)

2. In light of the law, busing districts may opt to: (a) provide a bus, or (b) offer aid in lieu of transportation in the amount not to exceed the state limit \$1,000.00.
